

British Columbia Foster Care Education Program

UPCOMING CLASSES IN VICTORIA

The BC Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) has developed a standardized education program designed to build on the skills and experience caregivers bring to their role, as well as knowledge to support their ongoing training and development. The BC Foster Care Education Program is intended for approved foster parents who have a family care home agreement with the BC Ministry of Children and Family Development.

New foster parents are expected to complete the program within two years of their approved start date with MCFD.

The BC Foster Care Education Program is free of charge and consists of a total of 53 hours of training. It is presented in 14 modules.
